CRM (NDPS) 1289 of 2026

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the innocent driver who has been put behind the bar for alleged recovery of 516 kg of ganja; charge-sheet has been submitted long ago, the prosecution has relied upon 16 witnesses but till date the examination-in-chief of the prosecution witness no.1 is progressing. Therefore, learned advocate prays that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered the progress of the case, as a matter of last chance, the prosecution is directed to complete at least five relevant witnesses within a period of six months from the next date fixed.

At this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after the aforesaid period is over.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1289 of 2026 is **dismissed.**
