Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The husband of the petitioner was appointed as Karmee of Babupur Gram Panchayat and died in harness on 9th April, 2014. Despite completing all pension related formalities within due time the pension payment order was issued by the concerned authority on 10th November, 2014. The gratuity amount and arrear pension were disbursed in favour of the petitioner on 10th February, 2015.

The petitioner has prayed for interest on the gratuity amount and arrear pension paid to them due to delay in disbursal of the same.

Upon consideration of the submission made on behalf of the parties and material on record, the Director of Pension, Provident Fund and Group Insurance, Government of West Bengal and the Treasury Officer,

Malda-I, being the 2nd and 4th respondents herein, are directed to pay interest to the petitioner @ 8% per annum on the gratuity and arrear pension amount calculated from 10th April, 2014 till the date of actual payment of the amount. Such payment shall be made within one month from the date of communication of this order.

With the above observations and directions the writ petition is disposed of.

There shall, however, be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit is invited, the allegations contained in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
