1. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been implicated on alleged recovery of 204 kgs of *ganja*. It has been submitted that the petitioner No. 3 is the driver of the vehicle while petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 were speaking with the driver of the vehicle, i.e., petitioner No. 3. All the accused persons were intercepted at the spot. Till date, only four (04) witnesses have been examined and the prosecution, as a whole, intends to examine ten (10) witnesses.
2. Learned advocate appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail as huge quantity of contraband/*ganja* was seized in the present case.

3. I have taken into account the stage of the case and as a matter of last chance, I direct the learned Trial Court to conclude the evidence of rest of the witnesses within a period of six (06) months from the date of communication of this order.
4. At this stage, the prayer for bail of the petitioners is **rejected**.
5. Accordingly, **CRM (NDPS) 1351 of 2026** is **dismissed**.
