1. None appears for the petitioner on call.
2. Learned counsel for the opposite party submits that the transfer application in the present case relates to Misc. Case no. 49 of 2019 under Order 9 Rule 13 of the Civil Procedure Code, wherein the Matrimonial Suit has been decreed ex parte and the petitioner has prayed for setting aside of the said decree by way of filing the misc. case.
3. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the opposite party that the misc. case is at the stage of evidence.
