1. The grievance of the petitioner is directed against non-payment of compensation in respect of high tension line which has been drawn over the land belonging to the petitioner. On behalf of the WBSETCL, it is submitted that they have no objection if the representation of the petitioner is considered by the concerned authorities in accordance with law.

2. In view of the above, WPA/15629/2025 stand disposed of by directing the Managing Director, West Bengal State Electricity Transmission

Company Limited being the respondent no. 2 to nominate a competent and authorized employee to consider the claim of compensation made by the petitioner dated 28th May, 2025.

3. It is made clear that there has been no adjudication on merits and all questions are left open to be decided.

4. It is expected that the authorized representative shall consider and dispose of the representation within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of this order.

5. Since no affidavits have been filed the allegations contained in the petition are not admitted.
