an authority under the West Bengal Land Reforms Act,

remedy under the 1997 Act, this Court is not inclined to
entertain this writ petition.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed as

approaching the appropriate authority in accordance with
law on the selfsame cause of action.
