1. Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Parties are represented.
3. Mr. Khan and Mr. Deb Roy, learned advocate for the respective parties have unanimously submitted as regards compliance of the Court's order dated October 4, 2024 by the alleged contemnor.
4. A letter addressed to the petitioner by the Secretary, State Regional Transport Authority, West Bengal dated March 12, 2026 is handed over to Court and taken on record.
5. In consideration of the submissions made by learned respective advocates as well as the letter dated March 12, 2026, the Court is of the considered opinion that the order under contempt dated October 4, 2024 has been substantially complied with by the alleged contemnor.
