1. The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that she is similarly placed as the other co-accused persons, who has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP (Crl.) No.13987/2025 in connection with the present case.
2. I have taken into account the case diary produced by the learned advocate for the State and I find that the present petitioner, Radha Bibi is similarly placed as Sentu Seikh.
3. Having considered the same, I am of the opinion that the same privilege be extended to the present petitioner.
4. As such, the learned Trial Court/Judge Special Court under the NDPS Act is directed to release the petitioner on bail on the same

terms and conditions as imposed upon the co-accused Sentu Seikh.

5. Accordingly, the CRM (NDPS) 1038 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.
