The petitioner has claimed compensation alleging that the plots of the petitioner have been utilized for the purpose of a Railway project.

The written instruction filed by the learned Advocate for the Union of India is taken on record.

The learned Advocate for the Union of India submits that the plots of the petitioner as stated in paragraph 4 of the writ petition have never been acquired by the Railway Authorities.

Such submission of the learned Advocate for the Railway Authorities is placed on record.
