- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 219 of 2025 from the Court of learned Additional District Judge, 3rd Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas to the Court of learned District Judge, Bankura.
- 2.** On hearing the learned counsels for the parties and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Alipore Court, South 24 Parganas by the husband/opposite party herein.
- 3.** The petitioner/wife herein resides at Guniada, P.O.- Guniada, District- Bankura.
- 4.** Considering the said difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Alipore Court, on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S.**

Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12) and on consent of both parties, directs that Matrimonial Suit No. 219 of 2025 be withdrawn from the Court of learned Additional District Judge, 3rd Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas and be transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Bankura.

5. Learned District Judge, Bankura shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.

6. Keeping in mind the case of the parties herein, the learned District Judge shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if such prayer is made.

7. CO 3558 of 2025 is disposed of.

9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Courts for immediate compliance.
