1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. Instruction forwarded by the District Inspector of Schools, Secondary Education, South-24 Parganas signed on 23rd July, 2025 filed in Court today be retained with the records.
3. The petitioner’s application for transfer on self-medical ground is pending consideration at the end of the West Bengal Central School Service Commission.
4. Without entering into the merit of the said application the instant writ petition stands disposed of by directing the Secretary of the West Bengal Central School Service Commission to take necessary steps to dispose of the application for transfer made by the petitioner

in accordance with law at the earliest but positively within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.

5. If required, further health checkup of the petitioner may be conducted by the Commission, in accordance with law.
6. The fate of the petitioner's application shall be made known to the petitioner immediately thereafter.
7. If the application of the petitioner is allowed, then necessary consequential steps shall be taken without any further delay.
8. Suspension of the Utsashree portal shall not stand in the way of the respondents in taking steps in terms of the order passed hereinabove.
9. The writ petition stands disposed of.
10. Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties upon compliance of all requisite formalities.
