Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of
time and there has been no progress and the petitioner has
been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused.

On the other hand learned advocate for the State
opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the Hon'ble
Supreme Court has granted time for concluding the trial within
a year. So far as the present petitioner is concerned, it has
been pointed out by the State that CDR was sent after
extracting and/or retrieving the data from the mobile phone
and the same has matched according to the report.

Having considered the complicity of the present petitioner, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1231 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
