Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, submits that majority of the witnesses have been completed by the prosecution and only the persons associated with the investigation of the police department are left for examination.

Learned trial court would ensure that the verdict is pronounced by 31st May, 2026.

However, having considered that the case is at the final stage, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**
