Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 2 months and the
evidence of the victim has already been concluded.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and draws the attention of the Court to the statement of
the victim under Section 183 of the BNSS.

I have taken into account the statement of the victim,
the deposition of the victim, the medical evidence which is
appearing and the overall circumstances. Having regard to the

present stage of the case and the period of detention, I am of the view further incarceration of the petitioner is unwarranted.

As such the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Petitioner, namely, **Preetam Biswas @ Pritam Biswas** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Special Court (under POCSO Act), Barasat, 24 Parganas North.

If on bail petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of 24 Parganas North without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Additionally petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of Electronic Complex Police Station without prior permission of the Learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2048 of 2025 is **allowed**.

All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
