CRM (M) 2113 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kaliganj Police Station Case no. 755 of 2024 dated 02.09.2024 under Sections 65(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and under Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner prays for bail as the petitioner is in custody for more than 16 months. Learned advocate submits that there is no possibility of the trial being completed in near future, as such the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State has submitted the evidence of the victim. At the time of commission of the alleged offence victim was for about four years, although, the examination of the victim is over.

I have taken into account the statement of the victim including the medical report in the present case and having

considered the same, I am of the view that this is not a fit case for releasing the petitioner on bail.

It has been informed that nine more witnesses are required to be examined.

In view of the aforesaid, I direct the learned trial Court to fix schedule of three dates and put in efforts so that within a reasonable period of time the evidence of the case is over.

Pursuant to the service effected by the State, learned advocate for the de-facto complainant is present and has also opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the totality of the circumstances, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (M) 2113 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

Report submitted by the State be kept with the record.
