1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of a partition suit being Title Suit No.210 of 2020 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court, Contai, Purba Medinipur.

Having regard to the nature of the order proposed to be passed, direction for prior service of notice on the opposite parties is not being made, however, the petitioners shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
