1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. By the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks for direction upon the respondent authorities to allow her prayer for inter-District transfer from District of Murshidabad to Birbhum District on special ground.
3. The petitioner contends that she joined as an Assistant Teacher in 61 Jhilera Primary School P.O. Sahora, District Murshidabad on 13th February, 2010. Upon completion of probation period, the service of the petitioner has been confirmed on 13th February, 2012. On 5th February, 2024 the husband of the petitioner

namely, Bamdev Bhalla died and the petitioner became widow. On 9th September, 2025 the petitioner made a representation before respondent no.2, Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education, seeking transfer on special ground. However, the said representation is still pending consideration. Hence, this writ petition.

4. Mr. Sudip Ghosh Chowdhury, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the matter may be relegated to the appropriate authority for consideration of the representation of the petitioner dated 9th September, 2025 for her transfer, in accordance with law.
5. Learned Advocate for appearing respondent leaves the matter to the discretion of the Court.
6. In view of the submissions advanced on behalf of the respective parties, the respondent No.2, the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education, is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 9th September, 2025 and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order, in accordance with law, upon notice to the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.
7. The reasoned shall be communicated to the petitioner within one week from the date of passing of such order.
8. Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to communicate this order to the respondent no.2, the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education.

9. With the above direction, the writ petition being **WPA 24809 of 2025** stands disposed of.
10. Since no affidavits have been called for, the allegation made in the writ petition is deemed to be not admitted.
11. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
12. All connected applications, if any, stand disposed of.
13. There shall be no order as to costs.
14. All concerned parties shall act in terms of the copy of the order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
15. Urgent Photostat certified copy of the order, if applied for, be given to the parties on compliance of all necessary legal formalities.
