1. None appears on behalf of the appellant even in pass over round. However, the learned advocate for the respondent/State and learned advocate for the respondent nos. 6 and 7 are present.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the respondent nos. 6 and 7 that pursuant to the Court's order dated 26.02.2026, the appellant has not supplied the copy of the memorandum of appeal along with connected application and the supplementary affidavit as yet.
3. In view of absence of the appellant in pass over round and on account of failure to

comply our earlier order dated 26.02.2026 by the appellant, we have every reason to believe that the appellant has lost his interest in the instant appeal.
