Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and draws the attention of the court *particularly* to the act of the son having assaulted severely resulting in the death of his father.

Having considered the heinousness of the offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

Accordingly, CRM(M) 2382 of 2025 is **dismissed.**
