C.R.M. (M) 2400 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Goalpokher Police Station Case No. 530 of 2023 dated 21.09.2023 under Sections 302/212/120B of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25(i)(a)/27/35 of the Arms Act (G.R. Case No. 2769 of 2023).

Learned senior advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than 2 years 3 months. According to the learned senior advocate, petitioner is similarly placed as the other accused person who has been granted bail in CRM (DB) 486 of 2025.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the said order which was passed in CRM (DB) 486 of 2025 was challenged before the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No.17200/2025. However, the same was without any success.

Having considered that the petitioner is similarly placed as the other accused who has been granted bail in

CRM (DB) 486 of 2025, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Md. Ali** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Islampur, Uttar Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Uttar Dinajpur without prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (M) 2400 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
