- 1.** Affidavit of service filed be kept with the record.
- 2.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 186 of 2021 from the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge (F.T.C.) at Chandannagar to the Court of the Learned District Judge, Nadia at Krishnagar.
- 3.** On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge at Chandannagar by the husband/opposite party herein.
- 4.** The petitioner/wife herein resides at M. M. Ghosh Street, P.O.- Krishnagar,

P. S. Kotwali, District – Nadia, PIN 741101.

5. Considering the difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Court of Chandannagar Court on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12) and on consent of both parties,*** directs that Matrimonial Suit No. 186 of 2021 be withdrawn from the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge at Chandannagar and be transferred to the Court of the Learned District Judge, Nadia at Krishnagar.
6. Learned District Judge, Nadia at Krishnagar shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.
7. Keeping in mind the case of the opposite party herein, the learned District Judge, Nadia at Krishnagar shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if such prayer is made.
8. **CO 3942 of 2023 is disposed of.**
