Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and draws the attention of the Court to the statement of the victim.

Having considered the same, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM(M)2479 of 2025 is rejected at this stage.
