Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 215 days; charge-sheet has been submitted and charges have already been framed. Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that considering the period of detention, further custody of the petitioner is unwarranted.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and draws the attention of the Court to the statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 of the BNSS as well as the medical documents which are available.

Having considered the sections under which the petitioner has been charged, *prima facie*, I am of the view that at this stage, the prosecution case is tilted in their favour. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

The application for bail, being CRM (M) 2463 of 2025, is, thus, dismissed.
