Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for about 297 days and the
investigation having been concluded. However, detention of the
petitioner is unwarranted.

Learned advocate for the State as well as the defacto
complainant has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Learned advocate for the petitioner has drawn the
attention of the Court to the fact that two of the accused
persons being Pramatha Das and Pinki Das have been granted
bail in CRM (M) 1737 of 2025.

Having considered prima facie that petitioner is similarly situated, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Swapan Bhowmik** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Raiganj, Uttar Dinajpur.

If on bail petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Uttar Dinajpur without the prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2499 of 2025 is **allowed**.
