In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Polba Police Station Case No. 18 of 2023 dated 12.01.2023 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code alternatively Section 305 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 66E of the Information Technology Act and Section 14 of the POCSO Act.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than 2 years 1 month. Learned advocate submits that there has hardly been any progress in the case and only five witnesses have been examined. The prosecution intends to examine 18 witnesses. As such, petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the merits of the case which reflect that the present petitioner established an extramarital affair with the deceased and circulated intimate pictures which breach the privacy for which at the matrimonial home, the deceased was compelled to commit suicide. Petitioner being the sole responsible person in the offence particularly

with regard to circulation of obscene materials, I am of the view that this is not a fit case for granting bail to the petitioner. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

However, State would expedite the process of trial.

Report submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the State be kept with the record.

The application for bail, being CRM (M) 2627 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
