Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It appears that apart from the allegation regarding offences under the NDPS Act, there is an allegation that the petitioner has been harbouring Bangladeshi nationals. There is another criminal antecedent with similar allegations.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
