Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for one year eight months and out of the 17 witnesses cited in the charge-sheet only three witnesses have been examined till date.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are overwhelming materials so far as the present petitioner is concerned.

However, the attention of the court has been drawn to the relevant documents which are appearing in the Case Diary.

Having regard to the complicity of the present petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Rejected.

Accordingly, CRM(M) 2648 of 2025 is **dismissed.**
