Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for 2 years and 6 months.
According to the petitioner, he has been falsely implicated in
the present case and there is no possibility of the trial
concluding, as such the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the case
diary, drawn the attention of the Court to the statement of the
victim as well as some other witnesses.

Learned advocate for the defacto complainant is also present.

I have taken into account the fact that the evidence of the two victims are not yet over. Having considered the same, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (M) 2689 of 2025 is **rejected**.
