- 1) Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
- 2) Petitioner is working as Constable in Border Security Force (BSF) and apprehending that he may be removed from service present writ petition is filed.
- 3) However, from the submission made on behalf of the petitioner it is found that till date no adverse order has been passed against the petitioner.
- 4) Union of India is represented by learned advocate.
- 5) Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the parties, it is found that writ petition is premature and same is not maintainable at this stage.
- 6) Hence, writ petition stands dismissed.
- 7) However, this order shall not preclude the petitioner to take steps in accordance with law if any order is passed against the petitioner in future relating to his service.
