Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody for three years three months and till date no witness has been examined.

State has failed to execute its duties. The Superintendent of Police, Baruipur Police District is directed to engage a Nodal Officer who will monitor the day to day progress of the trial.

Learned Special Court is directed to fix a schedule consisting of three dates and in a month at least one schedule be fixed. At least 10 witnesses be examined within the next five months.

So far as the merits of the case are concerned, I have assessed the same and I am of the view that this is not a fit case for granting bail.

As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (M) 2704 of 2025 is **rejected**.

Petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the aforesaid period is over.
