Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

The prosecution case is that the petitioners misrepresented themselves to be heirs of the de facto complainant and his brother by showing the owners as dead and then sold the property to the Durga Puja Committee. Investigation is going on.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
