NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody since 22.10.2025 and the
quantity of contraband so seized is of intermediate quantity.

Learned advocate for the Customs Authority opposes
the prayer for bail.

On an assessment of the records I find that the issue
relating to intermediate or commercial quantity is not
important in this case. What I find, the Calcutta Airport is used
for the corridor for transshipment of contraband from Thailand
by people living in other states.

Having considered the gravity of the offence and the manner in which the Calcutta Airport is being used, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1681 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
