CRM (NDPS) 1695 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **NDPS Case No. 10 of 2023 arising out of Purulia Town PS Case No. 160 of 2023 dated 15.10.2023 u/s 21(c)/29 of the NDPS Act corresponding to ST No. 60 of 2025.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was implicated in connection with the instant case for alleged recovery of 5.2 kg of phensedyl from the joint possession of the another co-accused.

It has been informed that the petitioner is in custody since 15.10.2023 and, till date, one witness-in-part has been examined.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail but is unable to dispute the progress of the trial of the present case.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am of the view that further custodial detention of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Ajijul Molla shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act-cum-Additional District Judge, 3rd Court, Purulia.

If on bail, the petitioner shall make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Purulia without prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1695 of 2025 is **allowed.**
