Report filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that there is no other material available in the case diary except for the statement of a co-accused. The petitioner is a CSP operator.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State relies on the report and the case diary and opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. She submits that other than the statements of the co-accused, there are money trail and phone call conversations between the petitioner and the principal accused present in the case diary.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary and the restriction contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
