Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits  
that the present application is for renewal of prayer for bail.  
Records reflect that last of the application was rejected by this  
Court on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Petitioner is in custody for 5 years  
and 9 months and according to the learned advocate appearing  
for the State, 3 witnesses have been examined till date.  
Prosecution has cited 19 witnesses in order to prove its case.

Without entering into the merits of the case and having  
considered the period of detention of the present petitioner and  
that there is no scope of the trial being concluded within a  
reasonable period of time, I am of the view petitioner be  
released on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely **Partha Talukdar @ Talukder** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Serampore, Hooghly.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Hooghly without prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

With the aforesaid observations CRM (M) 61 of 2026 is **allowed.**

Report submitted by the State be kept with the record.
