C.R.M. (NDPS) 1716 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Gangarampur Police Station Case No. 135 of 2025 dated 06.03.2025 under Sections 21(c)/22(c)/23(c)/27A/28/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused and the subject-matter of the case involves recovery of 125 bottles of phensedyl.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are antecedents of the present petitioner.

Be that as it may, petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused in the present case. Having considered that the rigors of bail are somewhat diluted in the present case, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Noor Islam @ Nur Islam** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the NDPS Act-cum-Additional District Judge, 3rd Court, Balurghat, Dakshin Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Report submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the State be kept with the record.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1716 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
