Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that although the accusations are for alleged recovery of 460
Gms. of Heroin but the two independent witnesses being PW 3
and PW 4 have become hostile. Petitioner may as such be
released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State submits that out of 9
witnesses proposed to be examined, 5 witnesses have already
been examined.

In view of the present stage of the case, if the 4
witnesses proposed to be examined by the prosecution are not

completed within 3 months from the next date so fixed, learned Special Court would release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 3 of 2026 is disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
