Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that recovery was from an open space and petitioner was shown arrested in connection with the instant case. Petitioner is in custody since 10.02.2025.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that earlier the prayer for bail of the present petitioner was rejected after consideration of the contentions advanced and there has been recovery of 4800 bottles of phensedyl which is the subject matter of the case. The delay in the present case according to the prosecution is because of the other accused persons evading the process of law. It has been contended that the petitioner has prior antecedents also.

Having considered the facts of the present case, I direct the learned trial Court to exhaust the process of law, split up

the trial of the case if required and proceed with the case of the present petitioner.

Petitioner would approach this Court after the evidence of seizure list witnesses are over.

At this stage, CRM (NDPS) 19 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
