Although the prayer in the writ petition alleges encroachment of the relevant plot of land by respondent nos. 9 to 12, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the said respondents are, in fact, causing disturbances in conducting his business peacefully.

Such a grievance, however, cannot be adjudicated by this Court, as it pertains to a dispute between private parties.

Accordingly, **WPA 168 of 2026** stands dismissed.

This order shall not preclude the petitioner from seeking appropriate relief before the competent forum in accordance with law.
