Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation is
merely of non-payment of loan taken from a bank.

Learned Public Prosecutor representing the State strongly
opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail, relies on the case diary and
submits that after applying for a loan to the tune of more than Rs.5
crores, the petitioner sold off the collateral security given for
obtaining such loan. The money taken was also immediately
transferred to a company where the petitioner is the proprietor.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials
available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for
granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
