The petitioner in the instant case submits that till date the reasoned order has not been passed in respect of the hearing conducted on 10.12.2025.

Mr. Swapan Kumar Dutta, learned Government Pleader submits that the writ petition has become infructuous since the reasoned order has already been passed on 24.12.2025 and the same has been duly served upon the petitioner. The petitioner submits that till date the said reasoned order has not yet been communicated by the State respondents.
