The petitioner seeks parity with the co accused Javed Khan
who has been granted bail by this Court earlier.

Learned counsel for the State does not oppose the said fact.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is similarly
circumstanced with the co accused who has been granted bail by
this Court, he deserves the same benefit.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioner namely Israil be released on bail upon furnishing
bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only), with two sureties of
like amount each, one of whom should be local, to the satisfaction of the
learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siliguri subject to condition
that he shall reside within the jurisdiction of the learned trial Court and
shall furnish the address where he shall presently reside before the
learned trial Court, Investigating officer and the Officer in charge of the

police station under whose jurisdiction he shall henceforth reside. The petitioner shall appear before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing. He shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to adhere to any of the conditions as stated above without justifiable cause, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

CRM (M) 13 of 2026 is thus disposed of.
