In Re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Jaigaon Police Station Case No. 87 of 2023 dated 31.03.2023 under Sections 22(c)/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the present petitioner has been implicated in connection with the instant case on the basis of statement of co-accused and there has been no recovery from the present petitioner. Further two of the other accused persons viz. Goutam Karmakar and Aminur Hossain have been granted anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that W/P/A has already been issued by the learned Special Court. The case is of the year 2023 and the petitioner has been evading the process of law.

Having considered that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused, I am

inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. As such, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

As the charge-sheet has already been submitted before the jurisdictional court, this order of anticipatory bail will remain in force for a period of six weeks from date.

Learned Trial Court would thereafter take steps in accordance with law.

The application for anticipatory bail, being CRM (A) 30 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
