1. Mr. Sandip Guha Roy, learned Advocate appears for the petitioner.
2. Mr. Abhishek Sarkar, learned Advocate appears for the respondent nos.

4. The concerned bank account of the petitioner was freeze by the respondent no.3. The demand was for a sum of **Rs.64,000/- and odd**.
