Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 67-year-old and is suffering from medical ailments.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, submits that the petitioner is the owner of the land where cultivation of contraband has been going on, he is thickly connected with the offence and is in complete knowhow.

Having considered the fact that the petitioner *prima facie* is involved in such cultivation of contraband, I am of

the view that this is not a fit case for granting anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

Accordingly, CRM(A) 976 of 2025 is dismissed.
