The Court :- This is an application for grant of letters of administration with the last Will and Testament dated 16th November, 2018 left behind by the above named deceased annexed thereto.

After issuance of citations, no one has come forward to object to the grant of letters of administration applied for in PLA No. 74 of 2025. The Department has issued a no caveat certificate.
