2. During the pendency of the writ petition, the parties arrived at an amicable settlement. A settlement deed was executed between them, which has been duly signed and verified by the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. Pursuant to the said settlement, the parties have also executed a sale deed, registered as Serial No. 666 in the office of the Sub-Registrar, Bhoom, on 20.03.2026.
