PER COURT :-

1. Heard both sides.
2. Applicants seek to condone delay ranging from 2698 to 2826 in preferring first appeals.

3. The contesting parties are served, but they did not file any reply to the applications. There is no reason to infer any malafides on the part of the applicants. They are ready to give up interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. The lapses from filing of the applications till passing of the first order are attributable to the applicants. They are not entitled to claim interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. Besides that, applicants shall not be entitled to interest and statutory benefits for the lapses which are as follows :
