PER COURT :-

1. Applicant seeks to condone delay of 2361 and 2393 days in respective appeals.
2. The delay is sought to be condoned not only for the reasons stated in the application but also on the ground that acquiring body also prefer appeals against self-same judgment and delay in that appeals was condoned.

3. Applications are contested by the respondent/acquiring body. The delay in the appeals preferred by the acquiring body was condoned.

4. Appellants deserve similar treatment. They are ready to give up interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. The delay stands condoned on the condition that they are not entitled to interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
