CIVIL APPLICATION NO. 5798 OF 2025

2 This is an application for condonation of delay of 880 days caused in filing the cross appeal.

3 The learned counsel for respondent strongly opposed the application and submitted that there is no sufficient reason to condone the delay.

4 On perusal of the application, it appears that the delay has not been deliberately caused. Therefore, in the interest of justice, the delay deserves to be condoned.

5 For the reasons stated in the application, the delay stands condoned. The application stands allowed in the interest of justice. The cross appeal be registered.
